Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking, further providing for 2 unlawful devices and methods; and, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further providing for denial or revocation of licenses and for period of revocation. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 2308(a) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 2308. Unlawful devices and methods. 10 11 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in this title, it is unlawful for any person to hunt or aid, abet, 12 assist or conspire to hunt any game or wildlife through the use 13 14 of: * * * 15 16 (9.2) Any device or method that involves the beating of any game or wildlife. 17
